I have no shame in admitting that I really like certain colored coins....but I am very picky in the sense that I only like colored coins which have a high quality of color application and design. There are many colored coins that I might not purchase if the quality is not up to my standards. When it comes to my high standards, one coin that rises and surpasses that standard is the Canada 2015 Burning Maple Leaf Skull coin.

The Burning Maple Leaf Skull coin isn't just an ordinary colored coin, it's got other great features going for it too. What other noteworthy features? How about the fact that it has a full Ruthenium coat? And that full Ruthenium coat looks great. But there's more. There's also real gold gilt on parts of the coin, namely on the reverse side's raised areas. But the real attention-getter for me is the wicked cool life-like skull engulfed in flames it's the coolest burning skull anywhere?

Now the company that produced these post-mint Burning Maple Leaf Skull coins didn't just stop at these excellent features. When you buy this coin, you will also get a deluxe wooden case and a C,O,A. with a unique serial number for that coin. This coin is limited to only 500 2015 dated coins produced ever. Once these 500 coins are sold to collectors, no more can be back ordered.

I've seen a couple examples of this coin being sold for around \$165 (not including the \$16 shipping that some sellers charge) in the after market. If you can find this coin for less than \$150.00, then I'd recommend you buy it for that price. At the time of this writing, the First Coin Company is offering a special discount on this coin... it's less than \$130. And since the First Coin Company always pays for your shipping costs, you won't have to spend a dime more than the listed price as seen here:
